

Welcome to **IDPA**, hosted at South Kent Sportsmans Club.

The **IDPA matches** are usually held the **Second Sunday of the month**.

Set up day, and 101 class are held on the Saturday immediately before the match.

Cost of the matches is \$20 for non-SKSC club members, and \$15 for SKSC club members.

You do not need to be a South Kent Sportsmans Club member to shoot with us, for a IDPA match.

You may shoot one match without being an IDPA member.

101 classes are required, unless you hold a current IDPA membership and are classified, prior to shooting. 101 class is free. You must sign up for the 101 class prior to the day of.

If you believe that you may be exempt from the 101 class, please contact the match director. Usually if you have shot another pistol discipline at South Kent Sportmans Club, or can prove extreme competency.

101 classes are held in the IDPA/USPSA/Steel Challenge bays out back, please park in the normal parking lot, bring your gear and meet in the club house for class at 9am.

All action pistol sports run a COLD range, which means...no ammunition in the gun until directed to load and make read, by a Safety Officer.

If you would like to be added to the IDPA email reminder list, please contact Tom Tiethoff. Your name will not be distributed, in any way, and will only be used for IDPA and related info.

Required equipment: a strong side holster, some sort of handgun concealment clothing, basic knowledge of gun safety, be able to draw and re-holster your gun safely, a willingness to learn and have fun.

Strongly Recommended equipment: a double magazine pouch, three magazines total, 150 rounds of ammo per match (50 for 101 class).

Classifiers: will be held on Scheduled dates, announced in the emails. It is your responsibility to shoot a classifier. It is not our responsibility to host a special classifier for you.

Banquet: After the last match of the year, we will host a banquet. Everyone is welcome to the banquet, even if you are not receiving a plaque/trophy. It is usually, a potluck format. We also, announce the "Season Standings". The Season Standings, are an average of points per shot, per match, with an average number of matches required to be shot for the year. More info is shared in the emails regarding this.
